Epistle Reading: Gal 6:11-18; Gospel Reading Lk. 8:26-39.

Please note that our church is open for services with a temporary clergy assignment. His Eminence Metropolitan Ilarion the Archbishop of Winnipeg and Metropolitan of the Ukrainian Orthodox Church of Canada has assigned Rt. Rev. Mitred Archpriest Fr. Taras Udod as our interim priest. In addition, Fr. Deacon Oleh Romanyna is assigned to serve with Father Udod.

Our next Sunday service is November 13, 2022, at 10:00 am (English). Father Taras proposes to have confession on the afternoon of Saturday, November 12, starting at 1:00 pm. Confession will also be available on Sunday mornings during the days of Divine Liturgy. Please arrive for the common prayers for Holy Confession by 9:00 am. It is recommended that members of All Saints attend confession once every 3 months. Father Taras has requested that entry to the church proper during Sunday morning confession be limited to only those who are taking confession and attending the confession service to help maintain the privacy of our parishioners. Parishioners who arrive at the church before 9:45 am but are not attending confession are asked to remain in the foyer or the hall annex until the confession service is concluded.

Remembrance Day: We will hold a "Remembrance Day" panakhyda at All Saints on that Sunday, Nov 13th, (immediately following the Divine Liturgy)

Mask-wearing is no longer mandatory, and screening is no longer taking place. Because COVID is still present, we do however encourage people to wear masks and to take all the necessary precautions to prevent any spread.

Today's commemorated feasts and saints**22nd SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST — Tone 5. St. John Chrysostom, Archbishop of Constantinople** (407). Stockholm Icon of the Mother of God. Spyridon and Nicodemus, the Prosphora Bakers of the Kiev Near Caves

The Venerable **Spyridon and Nicodemus, the Prosphora Bakers of the Kiev Near Caves** fulfilled their **monastic** obedience by baking **prosphora** for thirty years. They are commemorated on **September 28**, **October 31**, and the second Sunday of Great Lent.

Life

St. Spyridon came to the **Monastery of the Kiev Caves** during the time of Igumen Pimen (1132-1141), when he was no longer a young man. There, he was joined by St. Nicodemus, and together they toiled and led a strict **ascetic** life while baking prosphora, a duty which they combined with unceasing prayer and singing of the **Psalms**.

St. Spyridon was illiterate, but he knew the entire **Psalter** by heart. Even during his life he was glorified by miracles. Once, his mantle caught fire from the oven. Yet, after the fire was put out, his mantle remained undamaged.

After their repose, Spyridon and Nicodemus were laid to rest in the Near Caves of St. **Anthony**, where the three fingers of the right hand of the **relics** of St. Spyridon are positioned to make the **Sign of the Cross**.
