SUNDAY OF THE PRODIGAL SON

The Sunday after the Sunday of the Publican and the Pharisee is the Sunday of the Prodigal Son. This parable of God's forgiveness calls us to "come to ourselves" as did the prodigal son, to see ourselves as being "in a far country" far from the Father's house, and to make the journey of return to God. We are given every assurance by the Master that our heavenly Father will receive us with joy and gladness. We must only "arise and go," confessing our self-inflicted and sinful separation from that "home" where we truly belong (Luke 15:11-24).

After the Polyeleion at Matins, we first hear the lenten hymn "By the Waters of Babylon." It will be sung for the next two Sundays before Lent begins, and it serves to reinforce the theme of exile in today's Gospel.

The weekday readings summarize the events of Holy Week. On Monday we read Saint Mark's account of the Entry into Jerusalem. On Tuesday we read how Judas went to the chief priests and offered to betray the Lord. On the night before His death Christ tells His disciples that one of them will betray Him. He also predicts that they will desert Him, and that Peter will deny Him three times. On Wednesday the Gospel describes how Judas betrayed the Savior with a kiss. Thursday's Gospel tells how Jesus was questioned by Pilate. On Friday we read the narrative of Christ's crucifixion and death.

Bring a prayer rope to be blessed today! Use it and pray the Jesus Prayer each day this week.

Wear your cross to church and kiss the cross each morning with a bow!

Every time you climb stairs this week ask St. John to help you reach Paradise with the sign of the cross!

> Ask the Theotokos to offer you and the world pure thoughts and ideas this week.

> > Place your palm branches and pussywillows behind an icon at home and in your car!


Refrain from TV, Internet & Phones to honor Christ's Death.

JOB OPPORTUNITY INTERPRETIVE GUIDE AND CURATORIAL ASSISTANT

Ukrainian Museum of Canada, UWAC, Manitoba Branch Located at 1175 Main Street, Winnipeg, Manitoba, R2W 384.

The Museum, founded in 1950, cultivates the diverse knowledge and appreciation of the experiences, cultures, and histories of Ukrainians in Canada, Ukraine, and the diaspora. Details of our activity are described in our website www.umcmb.ca. The Museum is incorporated in the Province of Manitoba and is a registered, non-profit charity with Canada Revenue.

Primary Responsibilities of the Museum Interpreter are:

- Guiding individual/group tours through the Museum, educating visitors about the history of Ukrainians in Canada and the diaspora.
- English language required and Ukrainian language would be an asset.
- Providing visitor service and a positive experience for guests.
- Gift shop duties.
- Answering the phone, responding to questions related to the Museum and redirecting calls.
- Assisting with curatorial, collections management and research projects.
- Performing start-of-day and end-of-day tasks such as security protocols, and leaving the Museum in good order.

Primary responsibilities of the Curatorial Assistant are:

- Assist with display and storage of artifacts to ensure proper conservation methods.
- Assist with researching origins and provenance of artifacts and assist with cataloguing artifacts.
- Develop story lines and themes in order to help organize displays and exhibits, including online exhibits.
- Assist in producing and disseminating promotional materials using digital technology.
- English language and some fluency in the Ukrainian language required.
- Maintain security during open hours and follow security protocols when leaving.

Competencies/Experience:

• Must be between the ages of 15 and 30, and meet all other eligibility criteria for the Canada Summer Jobs Program. Must be a permanent resident.

- Employment is seasonal from: May 14, 2024 through to August 31, 2024 subject to approval of the Canada Summer Jobs Program.
- The work schedule is 30 hours/week. The museum is open from 10:00am to 4:00pm, Tuesday to Saturday.
